APPLICATIONS ARE ISSUED AT TIME OF TESTING

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. **REQUIRED Documents to take the test**
 - a. High School diploma with Transcripts or GED Certificate with Test Grades
 - b. Birth Certificate, ID card, **and** Social Security Card (ALL 3 are required)
 - c. DD-214 (if applicable)
3. Must pass a Math Test with a grade of 72 or above and complete an OSHA 10 class.
4. Must appear for a personal interview with the Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee when scheduled.
